ACCESS AND SECURITY

The code for the main gated entrance and court combination code will be advised when membership application has been processed.

The courts are secured by combination code padlocks. After putting in the code, there is a button on the base of the padlock to release it. This code will be changed at the start of a new season and may also be changed from time to time. Members will be advised of any changes.

Keys for the clubhouse are available to adult members on application and subject to a £10 deposit. A briefing from a committee member will be needed at the time the key is passed over as it is vital that the clubhouse is securely locked up. There is an alarm, the code for which will be advised when the key has been supplied.

ETIQUETTE

Please wear suitable tennis clothing and non-marking tennis shoes.

VISITORS

Adult members may bring a visitor to play at the club for a fee of £3*. It is the member's responsibility to collect the visitor's fee. Please record all visitors in the Visitors Book kept in the clubhouse. The maximum number of times any individual visitor may play at the club each year is 3.

BALL MACHINE

Members may use the ball machine* for a one-off cost of £40 per year (plus £10 for clubhouse key if you are not already a keyholder). COURT USAGE GUIDELINES

Wear trainers with non-marking soles.
Be courteous to other players on the courts around you, particularly if matches are being played – wait for play to stop before collecting balls or walking behind courts.
Please ensure no chewing gum is taken onto court.
Please only take water on court (no hot or fizzy drinks).
Please put rubbish in the bins provided.
At the end of play, please lower the nets.
If floodlights are in use, please ensure they are turned off at the earliest opportunity when play has finished.
Ensure all gates to the courts are locked and the combinations are scrambled.
If the clubhouse is unlocked, please ensure someone remaining has a key to lock up before you leave.

EXIT PROCEDURES

Bring seat cushions in (if out).
Ensure kitchen is tidy, all crockery properly washed and put away and everything is turned off.
Ensure floodlights are turned off – switches in kitchen.
Turn off lights (toilets/showers have sensor lights).
Leave interior doors unlocked.
Close window shutters (control inside clubhouse).
Enter alarm code and press '0' (zero) – leave within 20 seconds.
Lock door.
Close door shutter – control on left outside.
Ensure all court gates are locked and the padlock combinations are scrambled.

FLOODLIGHTS

Floodlights are operated by four clearly labelled **GREEN ON** / **RED OFF** buttons situated in the kitchen. The floodlights are LEDs. **There is no wait time** when turning on or off, so please ensure that when you leave the court you have played on – unless someone is actually there to take your court – that you switch the court lights off immediately to save electricity.

COURT BOOKING SYSTEM



We operate an online court booking system powered by ClubSpark. In order to use the court booking system you will need to be registered. If you originally joined the club online, you should be automatically registered, otherwise you will need to be sent a registration invite email which will contain a link which you should use to set up complete your ClubSpark registration. This will then link your Wokingham membership with ClubSpark.

Following your registration you can book a court by logging into ClubSpark by clicking on the ClubSpark logo found at the bottom of the club's website or by visiting www.clubspark.lta.org.uk/WokinghamTennisClub and then clicking the **COURT BOOKING** TAB at the top of the page.

There is also a court booking app for mobile phones – further details available on the website.

You can book a court up to 6 days in advance. The maximum period you can book a court for is 90 minutes. No simultaneous court bookings are permitted. If you have booked a court but no longer need it, please remember to cancel your booking.
